

PROUD TO SUPPORT LGBTQIA+ YOUTH

(lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans, queer, intersex, asexual, +)

At The Link, LGBTQIA+ youth can access safe and stable housing where they are accepted and celebrated for who they are.

While *all* of The Link's programs serve and support LGBTQIA+ youth, The Link created Project Live Out Loud (PLOL), a culturally-specific rapid rehousing program, to address the significant inequities, distinct challenges, and increased risks that LGTBQIA+ youth experiencing homelessness face.

1 in 4 youth experiencing homelessness identify as LGBTQIA+ and The Link's PLOL program continues to grow to meet the increasing needs of youth in our community. Last year, we secured an apartment building where **all of the units are dedicated** to The Link's PLOL youth. It is a space where young people have a safe place to call home, can build community, and truly live out loud without fear or prejudice.

3 Reasons Why PLOL's New Building Is Special:



The Comfort Kitten

Miss Marsha P. Johnson (named by PLOL youth) lives onsite at the apartment building and is shining in her role as a comfort kitten and valuable member of the PLOL community.

Sara Cassidy, Program Manager shared, "A young person recently came into the staff office extremely upset about homophobic actions by a

relative. They laid down on the floor and played with Marsha for about 20 minutes and were able to calm down and go back to their apartment."

Onsite Therapy

Youth in PLOL have access to a culturally specific therapist who is onsite at the new

building twice a week. Youth can schedule appointments or drop by for check-ins, ensuring they have access to the mental health support they need in a safe and affirming environment.





New Community Room

The PLOL apartment building has a dedicated Community Room that serves as a hub for youth to connect, relax, and engage in group activities. Youth chose the furniture, artwork, colors, and the layout, truly making the space their own. We are grateful to the dedicated volunteers from the 3M Gives Team for making this space possible!
